Light up bracelets will be needed. Donations/sponsorships up-to \$25,000. It's a spin of Nickelodeon's people choice awards and double date. Some of the sponsors are: Eat stars/Jamba Juice/Century 21/ boba place. Mr. D mentioned that 20k from the sponsors. This night rally will have a community aspect. Money collected in the jar under a staff's name will decide who will be slimed. Shaheen asked if the money is not raised what will happen. Mr. D said they will evaluate and cut some activities if they don't make the money. \$5000 was requested from PFSO. Diana made a motion to approve \$5000 to donate to Dublead for night rally. Kristy seconded. All in favor. Motion was approved.
